

PostureRay Adobe Reader Printing Update


Adobe is aware of the issue.




As a workaround, please follow our guide for changing your default PDF reader from Adobe Reader to Google Chrome.

Open Default Programs by clicking the Start button (a) and then clicking Default Programs.



Next find Google Chrome and select Choose Defaults for this Program



Finally, with Chrome selected and a list below asking which file type to associate, choose PDF from the list
